ABOUT PAFES

Executive Order No. 138, otherwise known as 'The Full Devolution of Certain Functions of the Executive Branch to Local Governments' was signed by President Rodrigo Duterte on June 1, 2021.

It mandated the National Government Agencies (NGAs) to fully transfer the task of delivering basic services to local governments by the year 2024.

In relation to this, the Provincial-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Systems (PAFES) was identified as one of the key strategies to level-up agriculture and was officially constituted as a program by the Department of Agriculture.

Specifically, the PAFES is a formal inter-agency network wherein the National Government thru the Department of Agriculture assists the Provincial Local Government Units to strengthen its Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Program.



GENERAL OBJECTIVE

PAFES aims to establish a pluralistic extension system to enhance LGUs' capacities in delivering strategic agri-fishery interventions under a Collaborative Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Program (CPAFEP).

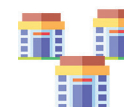
SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- 1 Establish Province-led Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Systems in all provinces of the Philippines.
- 2 Organize and co-fund Provincial Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Centers (PAFEC) and map out and vigorously implement CPAFEP in each pilot;
- 3 Institutionalize and sustain dynamic linkages with PLGUs, DA-RFOs, DA-BFAR, SUCs partners in the operation of PAFEC;
- 4 Develop, digitize, adapt, share, and utilize location specific and climate-resilient agriculture and fisheries technologies with farming and fishing communities.
