



Guidelines in the Implementation of Corn Production Enhancement Program (CPEP)

Memo no. 06. Series of 2023

Objectives

- 1. To increase the grain yield per hectare of yellow and white corn by 3% annually;
- 2. To increase income of corn farmers; and
- 3. To increase the supply of yellow and white corn for feeds and food, respectively.

Priority Areas:

New/idle lands, crop/varietal shifting & with average grain yield:

- Yellow Corn: lower than 4.20MT/ha
- White Corn: lower than 2.50MT/ha

Eligibility:

- RSBSA registered corn farmer
- Minimum of 0.5 ha corn production area
- Preferably member of active corn cluster organization

Provision of Support Services:

- For one hectare of corn area:
 - 18kg GM/hybrid corn seeds (yellow corn) or 20kg improved OPV corn seeds (white corn); and
 - 2 bags of inorganic fertilizers (urea and/or complete)
- For area less than one hectare: amount of seeds & fertilizer will be proportion to its area
- For area more than one hectare, the provision of CPEP will only cover a maximum of one hectare only

The DA-RFOs shall:

- Validate and approve the list of qualified beneficiaries submitted by cluster organizations
- Gather relevant data to assess project performance or activity contribution
- Provide support in the distribution and technical assistance on the proper utilization of seeds and fertilizers

The DA-RFOs shall:

- Prepare regional monthly reports for submission to DA-FOS
- Coordinate with LGU for proper planning, implementation and monitoring of the project

The Cluster Organization shall:

- Provide list of cluster members to LGU to be beneficiaries of corn seeds and inorganic fertilizers
- Consolidate the information/data and other pertinent documents (previous cost of production, client satisfaction measurement (CSM) forms) and regular report on the status of seeds and fertilizer utilization to LGU
- Execute the proper distribution of corn seeds and inorganic fertilizers to qualified cluster members beneficiaries approved by DA-RFO

The Farmer Beneficiaries shall:

- Provide data to cluster organization on previous farming activities
- Receive allocated seeds & fertilizers and utilize them following the recommended production technology
- Allow DA-RFO & LGU to visit there area to assess the performance of corn production
- Implement other recommended production and post-harvest practices as per advice of the assigned AEWs in the area
- Provide information/data, and other pertinent documents
